

Upcoming Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit Changes

Neighborhood News – January 2025

Effective **October 1, 2024**, Neighborhood Health Plan of Rhode Island's (Neighborhood) Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit made the following formulary changes:

- Neighborhood's Medicaid Pharmacy Benefit removed Basaglar and Semglee products from the Medicaid Formulary and preferred Insulin Glargine-YFGN, Lantus, and Rezvoglar.

Please note that coverage of short-acting insulins did not change.

Medicaid members who utilize Basaglar and Semglee products will require a new prescription for the comparative Insulin Glargine-YFGN, Lantus, or Rezvoglar product.

These changes do not affect Commercial or INTEGRITY Medicare-Medicaid Plan members.
